Application Guidelines – Master's Program Special Selection for International Students

Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences Kyushu University

1. Admission Policy

The School of Pharmaceutical Sciences and the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences pursue education and research with the aim of contributing to the improvement of human health and welfare. Toward this aim, the School and Graduate School seek to integrate and deepen sciences for materials and life, and systematically explore sciences related to the environment and the creation of new medicines for disease prevention and treatment to maintain and improve human health. The research achievements including the technology and techniques would be returned to people, so as to solve various problems in the 21st century in which the society is rapidly aging and people is surrounded by huge numbers of advanced knowledge.

In line with our vision stated above, the Department of Medicinal Sciences aims to nurture internationally-competent researchers, who can contribute to drug discovery and development on the basis of their knowledge for basic and advanced pharmaceutical sciences as well as well-talented skills for the analysis and solution of problems. The Department seeks individuals who aspire to be involved in basic scientific research or become pharmaceutical researchers or educators.

The Department of Medicinal Sciences provides lectures in English for international students. We welcome international students who share our vision and have great motivation and enthusiasm to engage in drug pharmaceutical research. The Graduate School of Medicinal Sciences International Course also welcomes applications from qualified students. Applications must be submitted in accordance with these Guidelines.

2. Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be of foreign nationality and be expected to acquire a resident status of "college student" after being admitted, and must satisfy at least one of the following requirements.

- (1) Those who have completed 16 years of school education or will complete by September 30, 2023, in a foreign country.
- (2) Those who have received, or are expected to receive a bachelor's degree or a degree equivalent to the bachelor's by September 30, 2023 by completing a 3-year course or longer (includes completing the course by taking classes in a correspondence course provided by a foreign university or an equivalent foreign facility in Japan, or completing the course at a scholastic organization admitted by the School Education System in the foreign country concerned) at a foreign university or other foreign schools (limited to the institution and its overall situation of educational research activities admitted by the person certified by the foreign government or relevant authorities, or the equivalent institution specially designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology).
- (3) Those who have completed 15 years of school education in foreign countries and who are recognized by the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences as having earned specified credits with excellent grades.
- (4) Those who are recognized by the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, through its own individual entrance examination, as having academic ability equivalent or superior to that of a university graduate, and who have reached 22 years of age by October 1, 2023.
- (Notes) 1. Applicants who qualify under requirement (3) or (4) above must submit to a preliminary eligibility screening. The application procedures for preliminary eligibility screening are outlined in the Section 10 below.
 - 2. Applicants should contact the desired laboratory head and supervisor prior to applying.

① A total of 15 questions will be asked. Applicants should select 6 questions from the list of 15 questions provided on the examination. Applicants may select any 6 questions they wish to answer. Each of 15 questions corresponds to the subjects (see main corresponding subjects) which are given to the undergraduate students of the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kyushu University.

② Exam questions are given in both English and Japanese. Applicants may answer in either language.

(2) English examination

Applicants must submit a valid report of the official score of TOEFL (TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-PBTor-TOEFL-iBT SpecialHomeEdition or TOEFL-ITP) or TOEIC Listening&Reading or (TOEIC-IP) taken after entering the university, which is in lieu of the English examination.

Applicants are desired to have English ability equivalent to or higher than the scores shown below.

Note, however, that these scores are not an application requirement.

Reference point TOEFL-iBT: 52, TOEFL-PBT: 470, TOEIC Listening&Reading: 500 TOEFL-ITP:470

(3) Successful applicants will be judged based on the grades of the above specialized subjects. However, for English examination takers, after confirming the results of the English examination that they have an English proficiency equivalent to or higher than the above-mentioned reference points, a selection judgment will be made based on the results of the above specialized subjects.

9. Application Procedures

Applicants must submit all required documents listed above to the Student Affairs Office of the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kyushu University.

10. Application for Preliminary Eligibility Screening

Applicants filing under eligibility requirement 2.(3) or 2.(4) above are required to submit an "Application Form for Eligibility Screening" (1) and other relevant documents from (2) to (4) below to the Student Affairs Office of the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences by June 30 (Fri), 2023

- (1) Application Form for Eligibility Screening (Use the designated form.)
- (2) Graduation Certificate or Academic Transcript issued by the institution from which you last graduated
- (3) License(s), Qualification Certificate(s)

(4) Research Paper(s), Certificate(s) of international activities or work experience

11. Announcement of Successful Applicants

August 30 (Wed), 2023, at 9:00 a.m.

The examinee numbers of successful applicants will be posted on the bulletin board in front of the main entrance of the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences. Successful applicants will also receive Acceptance Letters.

12. Admission Procedures

(1) Detailed information regarding admission procedures, including the admission procedure period, will be mailed to each successful applicant together with the acceptance letter.

(2) Admission fee and tuition

Admission fee: 282,000 JP yen (for the present)

Tuition: 267,900 JP yen for one semester [annual tuition: 535,800 JP yen] for the present)

Tuition shall be paid after being admitted.

(Note) The amounts indicated above are tentative and may be revised. If the above amounts are revised at or after the time of enrollment, the new amounts shall apply as of such revision.

13. Time of Admission

October 2023 or April 2024

14. Important Notes

- (1) Incomplete documents will not be accepted; due care must be exercised when preparing application documents.
- (2) Applicants with physical disabilities who require special arrangements for taking examinations or attending courses should contact the Student Affairs Office of the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences by phone or other means, by June 30 (Fri), 2023
- (3) When mailing application documents, use registered mail and write "Application for Master's Program enclosed" in red on the front of the envelope.
- (4) The contents of the submitted documents may not be changed under any circumstances. The paid screening fee will not be refunded, except in the following circumstances: (a) the applicant failed to submit his/her application documents, or (b) the applicant's application was not accepted.
- (5) Inquiries and request for an application packet should be directed to the Student Affairs Section (contact information is provided below).

To receive by postal mail a copy of the Application Guidelines and an application packet, write to the Student Affairs Section, enclosing a self-addressed (name, address and postal code) and stamped envelope.

15. Handling of Personal Information

- (1) The personal information written on your application form and documents will be used exclusively for the University's screening process and the following purposes:
- (i) names, addresses and other information of successful applicants will be used for enrollment procedures;
- (ii) transcript will be used for student support procedure, such as tuition exemption in the first academic year;
- (iii) academic records and other personal information used in the screening process will be retained by the University and used for statistical purposes, in such a way that the individuals will not be identified;


