1. Admission Policy

The objectives of pharmaceutical sciences are to integrate and deepen sciences for materials and life, and systematically explore sciences related to the environment and the development and proper use of medicines for disease prevention and treatment in order to maintain and improve human health. The research achievements including the technology and techniques would be returned to people, so as to resolve various problems in the 21st century in which the society is rapidly aging and people is surrounded by huge numbers of advanced knowledge. To achieve these objectives, the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences seeks to nurture capable human resources involved in research and education in the field of pharmaceutical sciences.

The Department of Medicinal Sciences aims to promote basic research in the fields of life science, biological information science and medicinal chemistry, as well as to develop highly qualified researchers and educators in those fields.

2. Purpose

Kyushu University Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences strives to nurture highly competent researchers, engineers and educators who are involved in the development, manufacture and management of medicines, as well as high-quality clinical pharmaceutical researchers who, as medication specialists, participate and function in health care teams in hospitals and other healthcare settings.

University reform in 1989 and deregulation of the University Establishment Standards have promoted postgraduate education for working adults, making it easier for them to pursue graduate studies while employed. The Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences has also opened its doors to working professionals. With the aim of further promoting interaction with society in regard to research and education, the Graduate School allows researchers/engineers working in public agencies or companies to enter a doctoral program to earn a Ph.D., while continuing in their professions. The Graduate School also opens its doors to retired persons who have worked in pharmacy-related fields for many years, so that they can pursue doctoral studies.

At the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, classes and research guidance may be offered in the evening or at other specified times, if deemed especially necessary for educational purposes. In such cases, scheduling and other details are determined through consultation between individual students and the Graduate School.

3. Eligibility Requirements

Qualified applicants will be:

- (a) Individuals who are employed in a public agency, private enterprise or another type of organization at the time of application, who intend to maintain their employment after enrollment, and who meet at least one of the eligibility requirements listed below, or
 - (b) Individuals who are 55 or older, who have five years or more of experience in pharmaceutical research, development or clinical work, and who meet at least one of the eligibility requirements listed below
- (1) Those who have been conferred a master's degree or professional degree.
 - (2) Those who have been conferred a master's degree or a degree equivalent to professional degree in a foreign country.
 - (3) Those who, by studying relevant subjects in Japan via a correspondence course provided by a school in a foreign country, have been conferred a degree equivalent to a master's degree or professional degree.
 - (4) Those who have completed a graduate school program approved by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology at an educational institution in Japan that provides graduate courses of a foreign university within the school education system of that country, and who have been conferred a degree equivalent to a master's degree or other graduate-level professional degree.
 - (5) Those who have completed a course at the United Nations University, which was established pursuant to a resolution adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on December 11, 1972, and is prescribed in Article 1, paragraph (2) of the Act on Special Measures Incidental to Enforcement of the "Agreement between the United Nations and Japan regarding the Headquarters of the United Nations University" (Act No. 72 of 1976) (hereinafter referred to as the "United Nations University"), and have been conferred a degree equivalent to a master's degree;

- (6) Those who have completed a course of foreign school, educational facility No.4 above or the United Nations University, have passed an examination or review corresponding to Article 16-2 of "Standards for the Establishment of Universities" (Act No.28 of 1974), and is recognized to hold an equal or greater academic ability than a person who holds a master's degree.
- (7) Those designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (Notification No. 118, Ministry of Education, 1989).
[Those who, after graduating from a university, were engaged for more than two years in research at a university or research institute and who are recognized, based on their research accomplishments, by the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences as having academic ability equivalent or superior to that of a master's degree holder]
- (8) Those who are recognized by the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, through its own individual entrance examination, as having academic ability equivalent or superior to that of a graduate in Pharmaceutical Science, Medical Science, Dentistry, or Veterinary Medicine, and who have reached 24 years of age.
- (9) Those who are recognized by the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences as having academic ability equivalent or superior to that of a master's degree holder, and who have been employed for more than two years in a public agency, private enterprise or another type of organization.

- (Notes) 1. Applicants who qualify under requirement (7), (8) or (9) above must submit to a preliminary eligibility screening. The application procedures for preliminary eligibility screening are outlined in Section 10 below. Applicants will be notified of the screening results.
2. Applicants should contact the desired laboratory head and supervisor prior to applying.

Note: Individuals who have completed the master's program of Kyushu University Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences and those who have withdrawn from the doctoral program of the Graduate School within the last five years need only take the interview and are exempted from the academic examination and thesis presentation.

- List of research papers (including presentations at academic conferences)
- Academic transcript and graduation certificate issued by the school from which you last graduated

11. Application Procedures

Applicants must submit all required documents listed above to the Student Affairs Section of the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kyushu University. An Examination Admission Card will be sent to each applicant.

12. Announcement of Successful Applicants

August 29 (Thu), 2024, 9:00 a.m.

The examinee numbers of successful applicants will be posted on the bulletin board in front of the main entrance of the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences. Successful applicants will also receive Acceptance Letters.

13. Admission Procedures

Successful applicants who receive an acceptance letter must complete the required admission procedures within the specified period. Failure to do so will result in denial of admission to the Doctoral Program.

Admission fee must be paid at the time of admission procedures.

* Admission fee: 282,000 JP yen (for the present)

Reference: Tuition: 267,900 yen for one semester [annual tuition: 535,800 JP yen] for the present)

Tuition shall be paid after admission via account transfer, in principle.

(Note) Amounts indicated above are tentative and may be revised. If the above amounts are revised at or after the time of enrollment, the new amounts shall apply as of the date of such revision.

15. Important Notes

- (1) Incomplete documents will not be accepted.
- (2) Applicants with physical disabilities who require special arrangements for taking examinations or attending courses should contact the Student Section for the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences by phone or other means, by June 20 (Thu), 2024.
- (3) When mailing application documents, use registered mail and write “Application for Doctoral Program enclosed” in red on the front of the envelope.
- (4) The contents of the submitted documents may not be changed under any circumstances. The paid screening fee will not be refunded, except in the following circumstances: (a) the applicant failed to submit his/her application documents, or (b) the applicant’s application was not accepted.
- (5) Inquiries and request for an application packet should be directed to the Student Affairs Section (contact information is provided below).
To receive by postal mail a copy of the Application Guidelines and an application packet, write to the Student Affairs Section, enclosing a self-addressed (name, address, and postal code) envelope with a 210yen stamp attached.

- (3) Academic records and other personal information used in the screening process will be retained by the University and used for statistical purposes, in such a way that the individuals will not be identified.
- (4) Personal information written on your application documents will not be used for any other purposes or provided to any third party without your permission, except in cases stipulated in the Act on the Protection of Personal Information, etc.

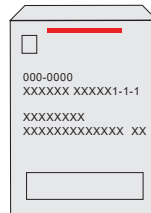
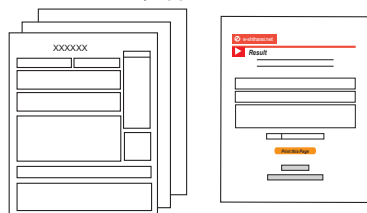

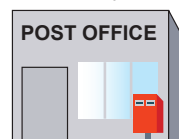
